Late Arrival/Early Dismissal Please inform your child's teacher of late arrivals and early dismissals. If you are dropping off your child after 9:20a, please bring him/her to the school entry and push the silver call button to gain entry. If you will be picking up early, please also come to the main school entry and use the call button to the right of the school door. Then, proceed to the school office to sign your student out. In either case, please park in a parking space instead of stopping along the sidewalk.
