First Semester: Australia The Asia-Oceania World Mission Team is made up of 17 missionaries serving 18 different countries throughout Asia and Oceania. The team—with members in Thailand, Hong Kong, the Philippines, and Australia—partners with God’s people to equip, encourage, and empower others to share the good news of Jesus Christ.

Two of these missionaries and their families reach out to disciple, train, and equip Christians in the South Brisbane Area, especially within the many immigrant communities. They partner with Our Redeemer Lutheran Church in Brisbane and Fountain of Life in Mayborough.

Through our chapel donations, we have collected \$501.35 for this mission! Thank you for sharing the love of Jesus in this way.

Second Semester: Immanuel Hmong Lutheran Church Immanuel Hmong is the only WELS Hmong Mission in the Twin Cities and has a total of 250 souls. They worship in a newly acquired church (formerly Shepherd of the Hills) in Inver Grove Hts. They are solely Hmong but speak both English and Hmong for worship services. Sunday school is in English for the children. Most of all the Hmong members are new converts from paganism (Ancestor worship/Spiritists) and are new to the faith. We pray that they will continue to be hungry for the gospel and grow to serve the LORD. They hold Sunday school at 12:30p and worship at 1:45p. Bible study is offered on Tuesday night and Confirmation on Wednesday night. We pray with them that the LORD will continue to bless their efforts and his church. Your partnership in the gospel is greatly appreciated.
